



One day, he heard that men from Europe wanted to climb the mountain. They needed the help of skilful Sherpas. Tenzing wished he could join them...







Sadly, Tenzing wasn't picked to join the trip. But he was determined to keep trying.




Two years later, there was a new expedition. No climber had yet managed to get to the highest peak.

On 29th May, 1953, Tenzing made it to the summit of the highest mountain in the world, where no one had ever been before.

#### Glossary

Summit – the highest point of a mountain

**Expedition** – a journey taken by a group of people for a reason, such as climbing a mountain or exploring a faraway place

**Avalanche** – a large amount of snow that quickly moves down a mountain

**Blizzard** – a powerful snowstorm with strong winds and low temperatures
